Athletes must meet minimum fitness test requirements at the Regional trials to be considered for selection.

SELECTIONS See *Players – Selection Process*

Selections are based on athlete skill, fitness and other assessment areas. Please see the Selection Process for more information. Regional squad selections are typically posted on the FHBC Regional web pages by the Wednesday following trials. Selected athletes will be asked to declare their commitment to the program by signing an Athlete Agreement and submitting a deposit by the given deadline.

TRIAL INFORMATION

Athletes must register and pay the trial fee online by the given deadline, attend and participate in the trial in order to be considered for selection.

Athletes must arrive 30-40 minutes early to check in and size clothing.

Athletes **must take a field hockey stick/goalie equipment,** hydration and snacks (if necessary) and wear appropriate athletic wear/footwear and protective gear (mouth guards, shin guards and a left-hand glove).

Athletes must read the Attendance Policy, Fitness Policy, Injury/Sickness Policy and the Selection Process.

TRAINING Players - Training Schedules

Regional Programs will target up to 40 hours which includes training on outdoor water-based turf, indoor hockey, FMS (functional movement strategies), Strength & Conditioning, sport science, injury prevention, fitness testing and education (and may include exhibition games).
