### **Learn 2 Win U23: athletes born 1994-2000**

The Learn 2 Win (L2W) Provincial Program will be offered to BC athletes in 2018. A trial and selection will determine the team and both men and women will travel to Toronto, Ontario (U of T) for the National Championship tournament in July. Eligible athletes are those born in the years 1994-2000.

### **1. Trials: when/where?**

- Registration for trials **\$0** (free!)
- Men: Saturday, June 9 @6-9pm at Tamanawis Park, Surrey
- Women: Sunday, June 10 @4:30-7:30pm at Hamber, Vancouver

#### **1.1 Timeline**

- Registration for trials open from March 21<sup>st</sup> to **June 6<sup>th</sup> at noon**
- By **Monday, April 23**, athletes must declare whether they intend to book their own flights and/or accommodation or whether they would like FHBC to do this on their behalf. FHBC will hold a number of seats and rooms. In such a case, the cost of flights/accommodation will be added to the levy and due by the mid-June.
- **Selections**: posted by **June 13** on the FHBC website. Payment due **June 15**.

## 7. Program Levy

\$280 \$375 per traveling athlete: includes National Tournament entry fee, luggage and training.

\$93 per reserve athlete: includes training environment only

FHBC covers the cost of:

- Field/facility rental
- Coach/manager honouraria, flights and accommodation
- Training equipment
- Coach Kukri clothing
- Athlete Kukri clothing
- India Club Tournament entry and uniforms
- Coach/manager tournament per diems

### **NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP: Athlete Flights / Accommodation**

Athletes can choose to book flights/accommodation on their own or request FHBC to book on their behalf. Athletes must declare **by Monday, April 23**. If no declaration is made, it is assumed that selected athletes will book and manage their own flights and accommodation.

Flights: morning of July 20 and evening of July 22

Accommodation: 2 nights from July 20 at the Courtyard Marriott Hotel, Downtown Toronto *475 Yonge St, Toronto, ON M4Y 1X7*.

Tournament dates: July 20-22

Ground transportation: not included in budget

Food: not included in budget
