



## Provincial Program U23 Learn 2 Win: athletes born 1996-2001

The Learn 2 Win (L2W) U23 Provincial Program will be offered to BC athletes in 2019. A 1-day trial will determine the training squad and both men and women will train (targeting 10 hours) in June to compete at the National Championship in Surrey, BC from June 29-July 1. Eligible athletes are those born in the years 1996-2001. This year, FHBC would like to consider entering two teams (per gender).

### 1. Trials: when/where/how much?

- Men: Saturday, May 25 @6-9pm at Tamanawis Park, Surrey
- Women: Sunday, May 26 @4:30-7:30pm at Hamber, Vancouver
- \$Free
- Open to all athletes eligible by birth year. Athletes must have a valid FHBC [Membership](#) to register. Island/Interior athletes also welcome!
- FHBC will be there with sample Kukri technical training tops for sizing (tank top for women; t-shirt for men)

By the Wednesday following the trials, training squad selections will be announced online. FHBC would like to select two women's and two men's squads. Team selections for the National Championship will be made and announced during the training program.

- June 29-July 1 U23 Nationals in Surrey, BC (see [National Events](#))

## 7. U23 NATIONALS Tamanawis Park, Surrey, BC, June 29-Jul 1

Athletes are expected to organize their own transportation, accommodation, and food. FHBC provides uniforms for the tournament.

## 8. Program Levy

All selected athletes will pay the full levy (\$250). Those selected as a Reserve (\$95) will receive a refund of the difference (\$155). **The payment deadline is May 31<sup>st</sup>.**

\$250 per Team BC athlete: covers the National Tournament team entry fee and contribution to FHBC

\$95 per Reserve athlete: contribution to FHBC only

### Field Hockey BC covers the cost of:

- Field/facility rental
- Coach/manager honoraria
- Training equipment and medical supplies
- Coach Kukri clothing
- Athlete Kukri clothing (technical training top)
- India Club Tournament entry and uniforms (if applicable)
