TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Trust Fund was established from:

- The 2001 Golden Oldies account balance at the close of the Festival
 - The funds accumulated from hosting the Vancouver International Tournament from its inception, less start-up funding, which was transferred to Field Hockey BC.
1. The purpose of the Trust is to provide financial assistance for projects that benefit field hockey as a whole.
 2. The principal may be added to at any time.
 3. The principal may not be reduced below \$80,000.
 4. The trustees may allocate annually an amount up to, but not exceeding the growth of the Trust Fund in that particular fiscal year.
 5. There shall be five Trustees.
 6. One Trustee will be appointed by Field Hockey BC
 7. Four Trustees will be elected at the Field Hockey BC AGM each to serve a 2 year term.
 8. In the case of a Trustee stepping down mid-term, the remaining Trustees may appoint another person to serve as Trustee until the election.
 9. The funds shall be invested as determined by the Trustees.
 10. The Trustees shall meet annually to determine which project(s) best meet the purpose of the Trust.
 11. This meeting shall take place between March 31 and August 31 when the allocation will be announced.
