



REGISTRATION & TRIAL POLICY

Registration

Registration dates and a registration link will be available on the Field Hockey BC website under: [Players – Trials & Tournaments](#).

Registration typically opens 2-4 weeks in advance of a trial.

The registration deadline is typically noon on the Wednesday prior to the trial.

1. POLICY: Registration

It is mandatory for athletes to register online by the given deadline, even if unable to take part in the trial (due to injury/illness/schedule conflict - **see #3**). Athletes who are not registered for the trial cannot participate in the trial and will not be eligible for selection.

2. POLICY: Trial Attendance and Participation

It is mandatory for athletes to attend and participate in all aspects of the trial. Athletes who do not participate in the trial will not be eligible for selection.

3. POLICY: Absence from Trials

Athletes who are unable to attend a Regional Trial can request to attend a trial in another region, if available. Written requests must be submitted by the registration deadline for the region in which you live. Athletes must still register for the trial under the region in which they live or attend school.

FHBC may consider evaluations from a previous year to consider selection.

The only requests that will be considered are those received by the registration deadline.

FHBC holds the right to review submissions on a case by case basis.
