

FHBC CODE OF ETHICS - OFFICIALS

CODE OF ETHICS OF OFFICIALS

INTEGRITY: The Official must act with integrity in performing all duties owed to athletes, the sport, other members of the officiating profession, coaches, and the public.

COMPETENCE: The Official must strive to be well prepared and current, in order that all duties in the respective discipline are fulfilled with competence.

ATHLETE'S INTEREST: The Official must act in the best interest of the athlete's development as a whole person.

RESPECT FOR THE RULES: The Official must foster in a positive manner both the letter and the spirit of the rules that define and govern sport.

RESPECT FOR COACHES: The Official must accept the role of coach in providing support for the athletes on the field of play.

RESPONSIBILITY TO OTHER OFFICIALS: The Official's conduct toward other officials must be characterized by courtesy, good faith, and respect.

PERSONAL CONDUCT: The Official must maintain the highest standards of personal conduct and support the principles of fair play.
