Field Hockey BC is now accepting applications for the role of Athlete Evaluation Committee member for the Provincial Performance Talent Identification Program taking place this summer.

2021 Programming and Brief Background

As many of you know, the 2021 Field Hockey Canada National Championships were cancelled earlier in the year, and with that FHBC decided to postpone our provincial team trials.

Although FHBC will not be selecting provincial teams this year, we are hosting a series of talent identification camps this summer to provide U21, U18 and U16 athletes the opportunity to be identified for the FHBC-Canadian Sport Institute (CSI) Provincial Targeted Athlete list. Provincially targeted athletes receive support and benefits through CSI Pacific, including free access to weight room facilities throughout the province. Provincially targeted athletes may also be eligible for the FHBC Elite Program. Athlete evaluation information will be shared with Field Hockey Canada to help them bring in a new pool of athletes to participate in their respective talent identification processes.

Evaluation Committee Duties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Report to FHBC Provincial Head Coach • Will consist of 3 to 5 members, or more depending on size of camp participants • Report any issues relating to player attendance, behavior, or injury to FHBC • Act as a positive role model for all athletes, assistant coaches, evaluators, and parents using FHBC values • Attend and contribute to any pre-camp information sessions presented by FHBC • Proactively promote Field Hockey BC in a positive manner • Provide appropriate feedback to FHBC staff during the camp • Participate in any post-event review as requested by FHBC
Eligibility Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To be considered as an evaluator you must have demonstrated experience in at least one of the following roles (current and/or past): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ National team coach ✓ University/college coach ✓ National team athlete ✓ Provincial Team Head Coach • Previous athlete selection experience is preferred • Knowledge of and experience in utilizing KPIs (Key Performance Indicators) to evaluate athletes is preferred • All candidates will be selected based on merit against objective criteria and with due regard to the benefits of diversity, equity and inclusion and representation from different genders
Evaluator Training	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All selectors will be trained on objective athlete evaluation criteria (based on provincial KPIs) and evaluation data entry methodology
